Academic Achievements

The progress and achievement of Orchardians has been very pleasing in 2016-17.

It has been a glorious year with significant heights scaled in academics, cocurricular and extra- curricular areas.

The major leap in Grade 10 board exam success led to euphoria, as quality was achieved at an impressive scale. The school average was **458.6** out of 500, placing the school in the first position in the educational district. The School topper, Mas S Gajadev secured a total of 486, followed by Ms Farheen Aakila and Mas Jagadevan scoring 482 to be placed second, while Ms Sapnapriya secured 481 and was placed third.

The first batch of Grade 12 students came out with centum results with Ms Momina Anjum emerging the topper with a score of 1167, while Ms Aparna V S of secured the second position with a score of total of 1150, with centum in commerce.

Planning, Scheduling and Orientation becomes the pre-requisite for any progressive execution and achievement. Recognizing the aforementioned fact, the management of Orchard Schools had vested its time and interests in orienting the orchard fraternity at various levels and occasions.

Competitions

Students had proved their mettle by securing laurels by participating and winning in the Badminton, Skating, Aquatic Sports, Chess, Yoga and singing in theological forums, Aero-modeling, Article & Story contributions too.

Master Gokul of Grade X, the winner of CM Trophy-Badminton at Trichy level was placed second in SGFI state level and represented the state in the National Level has won a Bronze medal.

Master Jagadevan K of Grade 11was placed third in the SGFI, Table Tennis, Divisional Level and was selected for the state level.

Irsath Ahamed of Grade 10, is selected to represent our state in RDS swimming competition winning three gold medals in 100,200,400 m Free style. He has also won silver medals in water polo, and in State Level for both 4X 100m and 4X50m free style swimming.

Master Rajkaren of Grade 9, has bagged a gold medal, in District level Roller hockey championship, Trichy and bronze medals in Open state Roller Skating Hockey & National championship Roller Skating Cricket.

Ms Ramya Bharathi of Grade 5 has seldom traversed a weekend without participating in a chess tournament held anywhere across the country. She has bagged several trophies and medals playing against categories higher than her own and the opposite gender as well. The latest achievement is placing ninth in the National Level Chess Tournament held at New Delhi.

Mas Shyam Sundar R of Grade 8, participated in Bhajan Samrat Season 2 Juniors in Sri Sankara TV and emerged a semifinalist.
