


EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

This club explored the meaning of heritage to understand ourselves better, and to appreciate the cultural interconnectedness of the past, present and future. The club members were engaged in activities that explored our personal and local history as well as world heritage properties to achieve our aims. The group watched AV about temples like Hampi, Birhadeeswara temple etc., explored about world heritage sites, played outdoor cultural games like hopscotch and indoor cultural games like thaayam, pallanguli etc., built their family trees, explored village histories etc

LITERARY CLUB:



A flair for language is provoked through literary club. The aim of the club is to inculcate elite oratory skills, interpersonal skills, communication skills and writing skills. The club helps the members explore the depths of

literary criticism and analysis as well as develop a sense of literary appreciation.

Children were engaged in the following activities : writing a new story involving characters from different stories read previously, making Comic strips based on the story read, creating stories based on a picture, story development based on a given beginning, reading a story and give a creative climax for the story, word building games, picture talk and listening activities.

COOKERY CLUB: Competent culinary skills are infused at cookery club. As Buddha said,

Awareness about nutrition, food safety, healthy eating habits, kitchen safety etc., are created in cookery club.

Healthy traditional food items like sweet aval, dry fruits balls, bhel puri etc., were prepared and relished by children. Food exhibitions were held were children got chances to exhibit their versatile culinary skills.

HEALTH AND WELL-BEING CLUB:

This club teaches children how to remain healthy and maintain personal and community hygiene. It is an association of students in school for taking care of everything that goes into prescribing ways and activities for students to possess good overall health (mental, physical, emotional,

and social). Several harmonious activities like yoga, meditation, Zumba, etc were conducted in health and well-being club.

Children performed role plays on the topic "Green Environment". They also measured their leanness or corpulence (BMI) for physical fitness. Children were made to prepare a BMI chart for their family to become aware of their health status. Then, children were encouraged to prepare their own diet plan for eating a healthy, balanced diet which will help them to reach their BMI goals and support overall health and well-being.

Art Integrated learning is a strong contender for experiential learning and cross-curricular pedagogical approach in the process of teaching and learning.
